


## Land Acknowledgement

We acknowledge Penobscot Theatre Company's presence on the unceded ancestral lands of the Penobscot people. The land from which we benefit continues to be a place of foremost importance to the Penobscot Nation and all descendants of the Wabanaki Confederacy. We recognize that the Wabanaki people continue to seek resolution on issues concerning water, territorial rights, and threats to sacred sites.

The Penobscots have inhabited Maine and the surrounding areas for over 11,000 years. Their ancestral territory included many rivers that flow into the Gulf of Maine, including all the watersheds from the Machias River in the east to Cape Ann in Massachusetts. The Penobscot Nation is one of the oldest, continuously operating governments in the world. The Penobscot Nation is part of the Wabanaki Confederacy, which also includes the Passamaquoddy, Micmac and Maliseet.

PTC resolves to be an anti-racist institution. We are proud to be members of the Wabanaki Alliance Coalition and are committed to living our values by promoting the history and cultures of the Wabanaki Peoples and sustaining an ongoing relationship which supports the art, resources, and values of indigenous peoples and tribes.

## A Letter from Jonathan Berry, Artistic Director

Hello -

I'm so very excited to welcome you all to the start of our 51st Season!

I'll always think of September as a beginning. It may be reflective of all that time I spent in school, but as the night air cools and the leaves start to change and the daily rhythms of young people return to classes and the regimen of learning, I have the feeling of having turned a page and there's a blank one in front of me, ready to capture the current moment.

It's always an exhilarating time at the theater, where all of our planning and dreaming starts to come to fruition as directors and designers share their visions, actors begin to show up for rehearsals, and our staff falls back into the reliable rhythm of producing art.

This idea of life's enduring cycle is one that is at the forefront of Noah Haidle's exquisitely lyrical, beautifully humane Birthday Candles. We follow one woman's journey through life - beginning on her 17th birthday and then jumping moment to moment, year to year, until we find her on her 104th birthday. Along the way, we hear her initial plans to live an extraordinary life, and then we watch as those plans are overtaken by the relationships she forms, the family she builds, and the quotidian responsibilities of daily life.

What she discovers is that the things that we cherish are less our accomplishments and more our connections -the relationships we forge, the people we hold dear. As the play progresses, Ernestine (our primary character) is baking her birthday cake. A simple recipe handed down for generationsbutter, sugar, flour - the simplest of ingredients. What's created from that, of course, is something so much more than the sum of its parts. It's a metaphor, sure, but it's also undeniably true.

There's an Allen Saunders quote, that goes "Life is what happens to us while we are making other plans" - It later ended up in John Lennon's heartfelt tribute to his first born "Beautiful Boy." The quote and the song, and hopefully this play stand as a reminder of where the real richness of life lies. It's in the day to day engagements, the relationships, the moments of connection. In a particularly divisive national moment, that's ultimately what I hope that theater can do and what PTC can offer: An opportunity to come together and find community.

Acadia Rep still operates on Mount Desert Island as a separate entity, while Penobscot Theatre Company is the nation's Northeastern-most year-round professional regional theatre in Northern Maine. Over its long history, the company has earned a national reputation for quality and innovation as its offerings have expanded and audiences have grown.

Even with solid attendance, the company's income from subscriptions, ticket sales, and program registration comprises only 40% of our total operating budget.
